The Premier Health Lung Cancer Screening Program with Low Dose CT (LDCT) has been designed for individuals at high risk for lung cancer and follows CMS eligibility requirements. **Please verify insurance requirements (CPT G0297).** All candidates for LDCT lung screening must meet the eligibility requirements defined below.

LDCT eligibility criteria (all criteria must be met for testing to be performed):

- Age 50-77 years
- Asymptomatic (no signs or symptoms of lung cancer)
- No known metastatic disease
- No diagnosis of lung cancer within past five years
- Smoking status Current _____ Former _____, quit _____ years ago
- Current smoker or one who has quit smoking within the last 15 years
- Calculated pack years _____ (# of packs per day X years of smoking)
- Smoked at least a pack a day for 20+ years (or the calculated equivalent)

The individual to be screened must have participated in a lung cancer screening counseling/shared decision making visit furnished by a physician or qualified non-physician practitioner (PA, NP or CNS) **(CPT G0296)**.

- Date of counseling/ shared decision making visit with required elements documented _____.

The Lung Cancer screening counseling/shared decision making visit includes the following required elements and must be documented in the medical record:

- Determination of eligibility as listed above
- Shared decision making, including the use of one or more decision aids: benefits and harms of screening, follow-up diagnostic testing, over-diagnosis, false positive rate, and total radiation exposure
- Counseling on the importance of adherence to annual lung cancer LDCT screening, impact of co-morbidities and ability or willingness to undergo diagnosis and treatment
- Counseling on the importance of maintaining cigarette smoking abstinence if former smoker; or the importance of smoking cessation if current smoker. If appropriate, furnishing of information about tobacco cessation interventions
- The furnishing of the written order for lung cancer screening with LDCT.

If a physician, PA, NP or CNS elects to provide a subsequent counseling/shared decision making visit for subsequent LDCT lung cancer screenings, the same criteria must be met as for the initial screening, and counseling/shared decision making session.
