New Option for COVID-19 PCR Testing

CompuNet is very pleased to offer an additional option that will greatly expand access for patients suspected of having a COVID-19 infection. This test is performed at CompuNet's core laboratory with recently acquired test instrumentation that provides for high-throughput testing.

If you are interested in collecting COVID-19 specimens within your office on symptomatic patients, please contact your CompuNet account representative for supplies. CompuNet will continue to offer COVID-19 PCR testing through the UD Collection Center for those who do not plan to collect specimens in the office setting.

PATIENT SELF-PAY OPTIONS FOR COVID-19 IgG ANTIBODY TESTING

CompuNet offers two options for individuals who prefer to order antibody testing directly. To utilize the UD Collection Center and to schedule an appointment, patients should go to https://www.compunetlab.com/covid-19-antibody-orders.html. UD Collection Center requires an appointment.

The direct option with no appointment needed is available at all CompuNet Patient Service Centers.

The test is payable at time of service (checks and credit cards) and the price is \$65. The direct option is available to individuals 18 years or older.
