



# Schedule a COVID-19 or Flu Test

Premier Health and CompuNet Clinical Laboratories offer screening (nasopharyngeal) testing at several locations throughout Southwest Ohio.

**A physician's order is required at all locations.**

**Patients must schedule an appointment at ALL testing locations, except the OnMain location.**

## Which Testing Sites can patients go to?

**Patients may go to any of the testing locations of their choice, as long as they schedule an appointment online with the exception of OnMain.**

**Testing is available for patients who are:**

- Symptomatic: Currently have symptoms of COVID-19
- Symptomatic: Currently have symptoms of the Flu
- Is your patient preparing for a surgery or procedure? Please see *page 4* to determine if they require a COVID-19 test prior to their surgery or procedure.

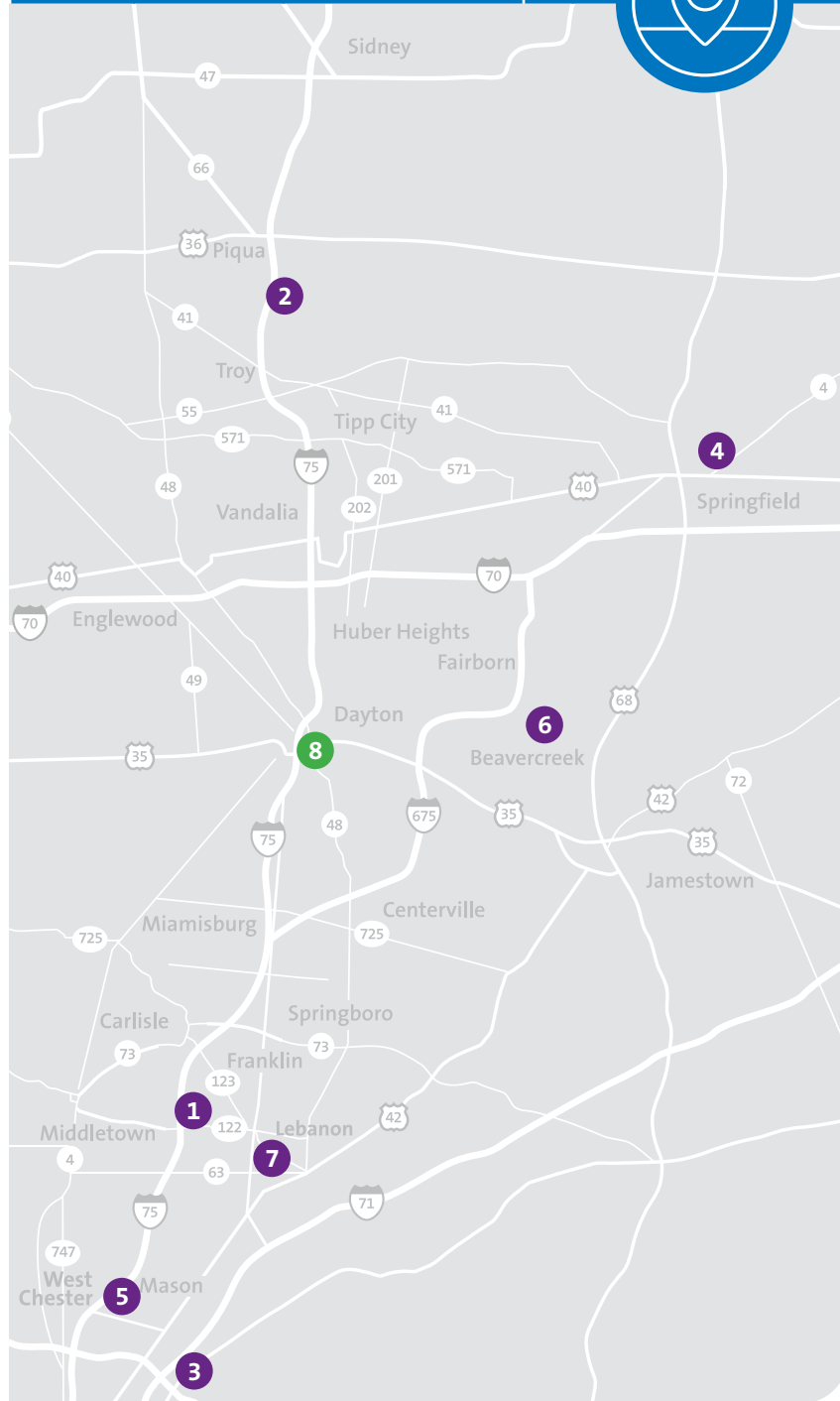

# Guidance for Screening COVID-19 Tests for Perioperative and Admitted Patients

## I. Outpatient and Inpatient Perioperative Testing

- A. COVID test required for all procedures unless a positive test was obtained in the 180 days prior.
- B. For patients with a positive test, unless contraindicated due to need, the following guidelines can be used to reschedule the procedure:
  - 1. For asymptomatic patients or those mild to moderate illness, medically necessary procedures may be scheduled at least 10 days after onset of symptoms (or positive test), provided patient is clinically improved and afebrile for at least 24 hours.
  - 2. For immunocompromised patients or those with severe illness, medically necessary procedures may be scheduled 20 days after onset of symptoms, provided the patient is clinically improved AND afebrile for at least 24 hours.
  - 3. For patients undergoing procedures without a medical necessity, strong consideration should be given to delaying the procedure for 7 weeks.
