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Scenario-Based Assessment and Triage of Staff Exposed to SARS-CoV-19

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has given guidance on level of exposure for healthcare settings. The exposure categories are low, medium, and high.

- Indirect contact/low-risk: an employee visited a school, medical facility, or other location in which a suspected or positive COVID-19 case has been found OR employees family member may have been exposed to COVID-19 but is asymptomatic
- Close contact/medium-high-risk: being within 6 feet (2 meters) of a person with COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time (caring for or visiting a patient, sitting within 6 feet of a patient in a healthcare waiting area or room) or having unprotected direct contact with secretions or excretions of the patient (being coughed on, touching tissues with a bare hand)

Employees with close contact to a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 while NOT wearing adequate PPE should report the situation to Infection Control and Employee Health. Find our more.

Recommended evaluation of patients with acute lower respiratory illness

This guide is established to help navigate the initial evaluations of patients who present with a <u>primary</u> complaint of Acute Undifferentiated Respiratory Illness. It is intended as a guide and should not replace clinical judgement as appropriate. Presently, testing for SARS Cov 2, the virus that causes COVID-19 is only recommended by the Ohio Department of Health for Tier 1,2 and 3 patients as noted below. This algorithm may change based on newer recommendation and updates may follow. Because over 20% of COVID-19 patients may have coinfection with other viral infections, Viral PCR is <u>NOT</u> recommended for ALL patients being evaluated with Acute Respiratory Illnesses unless clinically indicated for the <u>individual</u> patient.
