Patient Load Balancing at Miami Valley Hospital's Main Campus

Premier Health has seen their volume of patients (both non-COVID-19 and COVID-19) increase in recent days, they are taking several steps to ensure timely care for all of their patients. We want to ensure you're aware of these steps, which are part of our ongoing surge planning.

We are not, at this time, cancelling any elective surgeries. At Miami Valley Hospital's main campus, we have had conversations with proceduralists and surgeons to assist us in rebalancing the volume load of surgeries, when possible and appropriate. These conversations began this week and will be ongoing as the COVID-19 admissions increase.

Our goal is to proactively balance the patient load, capacity and resources to be as efficient as possible during this pandemic. This will help to ensure surgeries/procedures remain available for all patients.






Number of Positive and Suspected COVID Patients Admitted


Premier Health Lab Collection Center Positivity Rates
