





Founded in 1965, Samaritan Behavioral Health, Inc. (SBHI) provides mental health and substance use services for all ages in Southwest Ohio. SBHI offers mental health services in Preble and Miami counties, and both mental health and substance treatment in Montgomery County. It is a member of Premier Health.




SBHI is one of two operating partners of OneFifteen which provides a full array of substance service treatment to Montgomery County. Services include outpatient counseling, group counseling, care coordination, peer support, medication-assisted treatment, assessment and ambulatory detox. OneFifteen also provides inpatient treatment at American Society of Addiction Medicine Level 3.5 and 3.7.




CrisisCare offers 24/7 crisis services to Montgomery County. Individuals can access services by calling **(937) 224-4646**, walking-in to CrisisCare, or crisis workers can respond in-person and go to the point of crisis.




SBHI's Young Children's Assessment and Treatment Services provides early childhood mental health services on-site and in the community. This program serves children and their families from infancy to age 9.




Consumer Advocacy Model program offers mental health and substance treatment services to individuals 18 and older who are severely mentally ill and often dealing with substance disorders.



Miami County office, in addition to offering outpatient mental health services, also offers primary care to patients at SBHI's office at the Upper Valley Medical Center campus.




SBHI's School Services offers mental health counseling in the school setting in Montgomery and Miami counties.
