

Vocal Cord Surgery - Post Operative Instructions

What to Expect

- It is common to have a sore throat for 3 to 5 days after surgery. Avoid taking aspirin, ibuprofen, Advil, or other products containing these medications. You can take Tylenol for pain relief as an alternative to narcotic pain medications
- It is very important that you stay well-hydrated and drink plenty of fluids during the recovery period
- Avoid alcohol, tobacco products, spicy foods or eating late at night as these may cause heartburn or stomach reflux and may delay the healing process
- Avoid coughing or frequent throat-clearing. Drinking water can help alleviate the urge to clear the throat
- Avoid any heavy lifting (more than 20 pounds), straining, exercise or sports activities for 2
 weeks after surgery
- Follow your surgeon's voice rest instructions. You are to have absolute voice rest for 3 days. After that, you may begin to use your voice at a soft spoken level. You should only speak loud enough for people within an arm's length away to hear you. Do not yell or whisper. After the first 3 days of rest, you may increase your voice use by 5 minutes each day
- Call the office if you experience any of the following:
 - Fever higher than 101° F
 - o Complete loss of voice
 - Difficulty breathing or swallowing
 - o Bleeding from the mouth

Nutrition

Some patients have less of an appetite, but it's very important to continue to drink plenty of fluids. Drinking fluids will help lessen the discomfort.

Safety Information for Giving Medications

- Each time you give a medication, read the label
- Do not measure liquid with a kitchen spoon. There are pediatric measuring devices available at the pharmacy. Ask for one when you get your prescription filled
- Use the exact amount ordered by your surgeon. If you have questions, ask the pharmacist
- Always watch your child take all of their medication
- Store all mediations out of reach of children
