RE: Temporary Lodging for Health Care Workers

As Premier Health begins treating more patients in the coming days and weeks who test positive for COVID-19, we wanted to make you aware of a generous offer of temporary lodging for local health workers that is being made by Ronald McDonald House Charities Dayton (RMHC).

Beginning Tuesday, April 14, RMHC will make 13 rooms available for use by <u>all local health care workers</u>. Each room includes a private bathroom, and is furnished with two twin beds, a couch, an armoire, and a TV. WiFi is available.

Each room is intended to house one occupant per night. No additional visitors will be permitted. RMHC will clean the rooms between each stay, and the rooms will be "made up" upon arrival, with clean linens and fresh towels provided.

All common areas of the Ronald McDonald House will be closed except the laundry room. RMHC will make detergent available. A beverage area will be stocked with Keurig products and cold bottled water for guests.
